The assessment cycle for CCNA 2 and the Networking program is two-year cycle. This assessment started in the 2018-19 academic year. Faculty deploy the assessment skills exam at the conclusion of each semester. Curriculum is updated to meet CISCO and employer standards and needs.

4. What are the assessment methods? Are they direct or indirect?

The assessment method for CCNA 2 is a direct assessment of the skills taught throughout the semester. Students complete a practical exam using live equipment to create and basic security for a working network using routers and switches.

5. What are the assessment goal(s)?

The assessment goal or threshold for the CCNA 2 course is 75% of students will complete the skills practical exam with a 70% or higher.

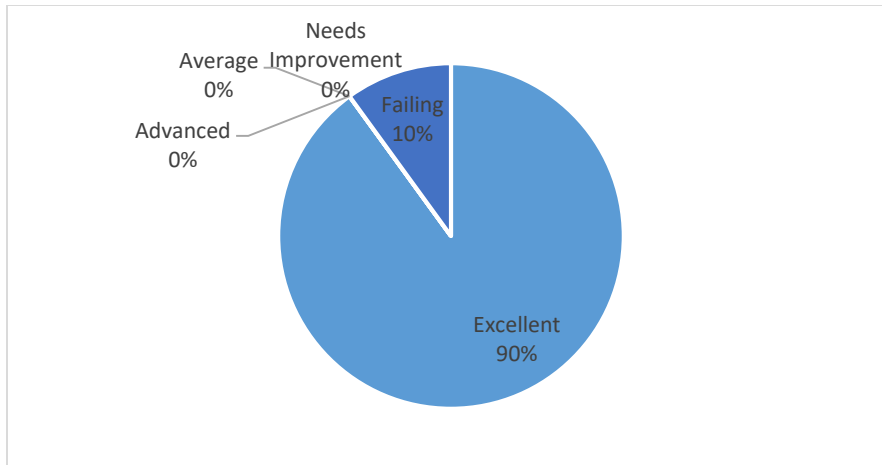
6. What were the findings for this academic year? (2018-2019)

A total of ten students completed CCNA 2, nine students passed the exam with at least 90%. Only one student did not achieve the goal of 70%.
