# 5. What are the assessment methods? Are they direct or indirect?



Students compose an essay with subjective and objective observations about a concert performance. Each paper is evaluated according to a rubric so this is direct assessment.

### 6. What are the assessment goal(s)?

The essay is an 80-point assignment of which 20 points are earned through 'objective observations'. Successful students should meet the threshold of 15-20 points on this part of the assignment, with 70% of the class achieving this goal, and/or an average class score of 70%

## 7. What were the findings for this academic year? (2018-2019)

The results met and exceeded the established threshold.

# 8. What is your analysis of the findings?

Analysis of Results: 86 students from 7 classes submitted essays. The average class score of 87.4% far exceeded the 70% threshold. The number of lower scores on the assignment has diminished. The unfortunate consequence of this assignment is that some students fail to complete it and therefore fail the class. It will be beneficial to improve these numbers to truly claim higher success.

# 9. What is the action plan for the next academic year? (2019-2020) Explain.

More guidance in the objective observation portion of the concert review paper should lead towards an even higher percentage of students reaching the success threshold.
