- 7. What were the findings for this academic year? (2019-2020) Passing grade for this course is 77%. The class average was a 77.7%. With the lowest score being a 61.8% and the highest being a 88.2%. 31 out of 40 students were successful in meeting the passing grade of 77%.

Effects of change in curriculum include increased patient care and outcomes, increased patient safety and less instances of incident reports.
