We assess students on the CLOs during each semester.

Direct through a final paper where students attend and write in an informed review of a performance (play or musical). The paper must include terms and concepts covered in class. This includes theatrical terminology, concepts involving the performers and the audience and identifying genre as well as stage type.

7. What are the assessment goal(s)?

Our target is for 70 percent of the students to demonstrate a comprehensive understanding of at least five terms and concepts of theatre through the paper.

8. What were the findings for this academic year? (2019-2020)

90 percent of our students passed the 70 percent threshold we had set for the final paper for the class.

9. What is your analysis of the findings?

We need to increase emphasis on these concepts so that a higher percentage of students will pass our threshold.

We will spend more time in concept review at the end of the year to assist more students with their final assessment.



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
