Dear UA-PTC Student:

The American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021 contains provisions for funding of emergency financial aid grants to eligible students who have experienced disruption to their education due to COVID-19. The purpose of these grant funds are to help cover a student's expenses related to the disruption of their education, including eligible expenses under a student's cost of attendance or for emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus, such as tuition, food, housing, health care (including mental health care) or child care. Funds may not be used for other purposes.

The Arkansas General Assembly enacted a specific appropriation that required UA-PTC to submit a request for appropriation that has been approved, and authorizes UA-PTC to process emergency grant refunds to eligible students for the Spring 2022 semester.

This notification is being sent to confirm that you, as a valued UA-PTC student, will be a recipient of a Spring 2022 ARPA emergency financial aid grant.

The **amount of each award** is based on the **number of credit hours** in which a qualified student is enrolled in at the time the Spring 2022 eligible student file was pulled, and the **student's Expected Family Contribution (EFC)** as determined by a student's completed 2021-2022 FAFSA. Students not signed up for direct deposit, will have a check ready to be picked on Friday 02/25/2022 at the Cashiers Window located in the Campus Center Building (CCB) of UA-PTC's Main Campus in North Little Rock.
