ProQuest One Business is a large business database that designed to support the unique needs of business professionals including entrepreneurs, accountants, and academic faculty and students.

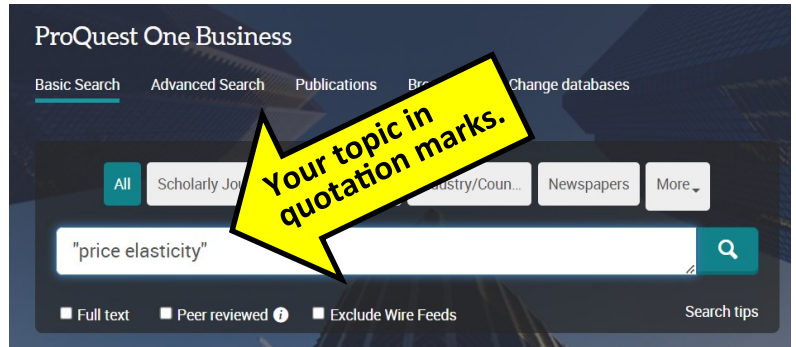
To get to **ProQuest One Business** start on the **UA-PTC Libraries** homepage: <http://www.uaptc.edu/library>.

- Click on the **Databases** button.
- Select **ProQuest One Business** from the alphabetical list.

ProQuest One Business opens to a Basic Search screen with a single search box.

Let's look for articles on **price elasticity**.

Type the topic, **price elasticity**, in the search box. Put this term in **quotation marks** to tell the database that you want to search for the entire phrase and not just the individual words. Then click the **Search** button.



Refining results and getting a copy of an article.

The next screen displays your search results in order of relevance. You can limit your results using the options on the left side of the screen.

Limiters

Check **Full Text** to limit results to those citations that have a copy of the complete text.

Use **Publication Date** to limit results to articles published within a particular time frame, such as the past 10 years.

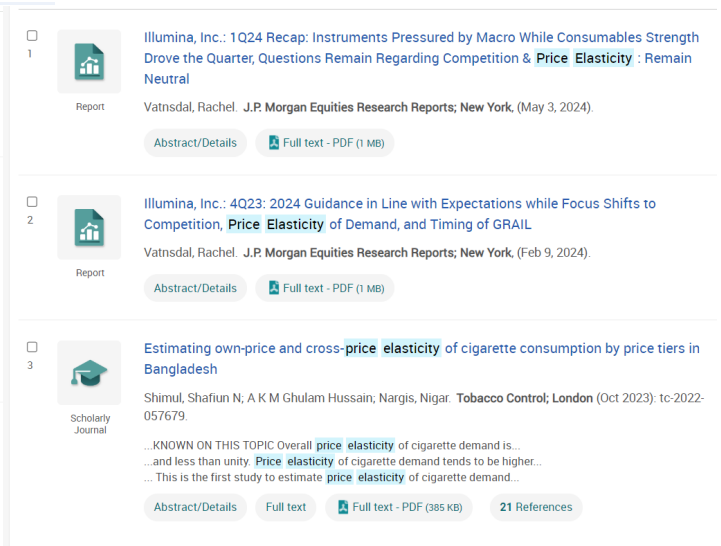

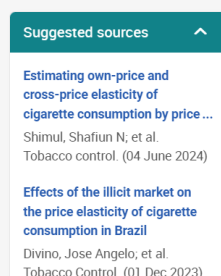
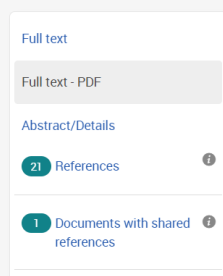
