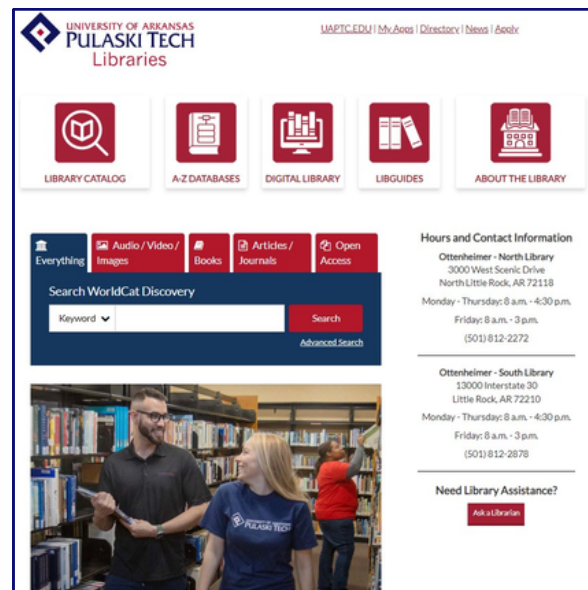
LIBRARY EVENTS

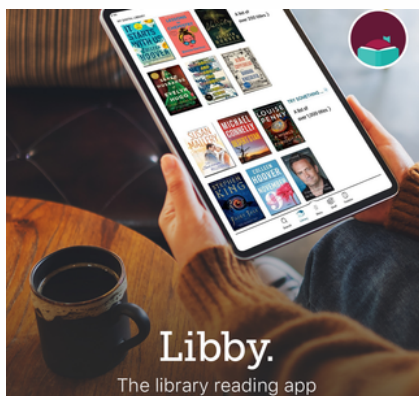


PRONUNCIATOR
