University of Arkansas - Pulaski Technical College is committed to providing a high quality, accessible, flexible, and affordable education to the citizens of central Arkansas. A high school diploma from a regionally accredited high school or home school or a General Education Development® diploma (GED) is required for admission to UA - Pulaski Technical College. First-time entering college students and high school concurrent/dual-enrollment students must also meet minimum reading test scores for admission. All first-time college students will be evaluated for the purpose of conditional or unconditional admission to the college

In accordance with Arkansas Code 6-60-208, all first-time entering students graduating after May 1, 2002 from an Arkansas public high school, out-of-state high school, home schooling, private school, or General Educational Development® diploma (GED) recipient will be evaluated for the purpose of conditional or unconditional admission to UA-PTC.

Conditionally admitted students must successfully complete the required hours of core academic courses and/or technical courses and any developmental courses by the initial classification of sophomore status (30 semester credit hours). Students who do not successfully complete the required core academic courses, technical courses, and/or developmental courses within the designated period will be placed on probation and will be limited to enrollment in core academic, technical, or developmental courses that will complete conditional admission requirements.

Acceptance to UA-PTC does not ensure admission to a particular course or to a program of study. Students preparing for admission to an Allied Health program should refer to the Allied Health section of the UA-PTC website or academic catalog. The prospective student is reminded that standards of quality are maintained and that students may be required to remove deficiencies before entering certain programs and courses.
