Public Law 101-542, the Student Right to Know and Campus Security Act, requires that campus crime statistics be made available to all current students and employees, and to any applicant for enrollment or employment upon request. Any incident of criminal actions or emergency that occurs on campus must be reported to a College administrator or a member of the College’s Police/Public Safety staff. The College’s Police and Public Safety Department personnel meet all state-mandated training requirements and report all criminal violations to the proper authorities.
