1.0 PURPOSE

UA-PTC is committed to educational quality and meeting the needs of the community by graduating students who meet the knowledge expectations of their chosen field, and the established general educational outcomes. The faculty members will work with the Academic Assessment Coordinator to develop and execute an assessment plan that identifies a plan, process, and reporting venue for program and course outcomes. These assessments will be utilized in making operational and strategic changes for academic improvements that affects the budget.

The main purpose of the academic assessment plan is to develop and implement assessments and Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) to be used in determining and documenting academic effectiveness. Assessment at UA-PTC serves as a means for determining whether student learning has occurred, as well as, a means for accountability checks throughout the process.

The Provost is responsible for monitoring and supervising the assessment plan.
