4.0 DEFINITIONS

Articulation refers to the relationship between educational programs from the secondary through the post-secondary levels which are designed to provide a smooth transition for students from one educational program to another, and to grant credit, where appropriate, for previously attained knowledge and skills.

5.0 PROCEDURES

To ensure that articulation between UA-PTC and other educational institutions is established, formal written articulation agreements will be developed. Such agreements should be signed by the chief administrative officer (i.e., UA-PTC Chancellor) and the chief academic officer (i.e., UA-PTC Provost) of each institution involved in the articulation agreement.
